
My Crystal Ball Says ...

Francis Asbury, August 20, 1745-March 31, 1816

Asbury was one of the first two bishops of the Methodist Episcopal Church in the United States.

He felt called by God as early as age 7. His family, persecuted for their religious beliefs came to America where he was ordained by John Wesley. He preached open-air sermons at courthouses, camps, public squares, and wherever he could find an audience.

Many deemed him to be a terrible preacher, but greatly responsible

for breaking down racial and gender barriers.

Asbury said, "We should so work as if we were to be saved by our works; and so rely on Jesus Christ as if we did no works."




