He is, He who is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow is in charge. Instead of infighting, let's try these few disciplines of faith:






This spot saved for your ministry announcement

The photo above shows a house that our mission team to Southern Kentucky started May 6. Subsequent teams completed roofing/siding, drywall/painting, cabinets/wood trim, and other necessary tasks. The home was recently completed and Tom moved in during the first week of September.

Ever have one of those days? Tom went into a meeting at the coal company where he worked and learned that he was no longer needed. While driving home, his daughter called him to tell him his home was on fire—to the ground.

Construction is just one of the jobs at Henderson Settlement in Frakes, KY. There is a team that prepares plants at the greenhouse for kids to purchase the week before Mother's Day. Other groups sort clothes; stock, organize, and distribute food at the food pantry on-site; and perform "other tasks as assigned."
